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Introduction

FOREWORD

The following pages contain, in picture-story form, the life of an "American" girl, Kateri Tekakwitha, the Lily of the Mohawks. She lived at an age when degradation and immorality reigned supreme among the Indian tribes of North America. The people of her tribe (Iroquois) were degenerate savages and her very companions were vicious, inhuman pagans. Amidst all this Indian corruption and degravity, Kateri kept herself pure and spotless. She was a bright light shining in a past darkness. From earliest girlhood she felt a special call from the God of the Christians.

Tekakwitha first met a missionary, Fr. de Lamberville, S.J., when she was eighteen years of age, and the priest was so impressed by her outstanding Christian qualities, that he arranged to give this Iroquois Maiden special instruction. After her baptism, when the animosity of her pagan companions became dangerously hostile, Kateri was sent to the infant Mission of St. Francis Xavier at Caughnawaga, near Montreal.

She arrived in Canada in the autumn of 1677 and at once her Spiritual adviser gave her a rule and way for leading a more perfect life, thus furthering God's design in the Indian girl.

After her death, Kateri's reputation for holiness spread far and wide. Many were the wonders attributed to her intercession, and to-day reports of cures and favours reach the Postulators of her Cause from many parts of the world.


Looking back almost 300 years to the time when Katari lived brilliant with the splendor of all the virtues, Holy Mother Church in a decree approved by His Holiness Pope Pius XII solemnly proclaims: "IT HAS BEEN PROVED, IN THIS INSTANCE AND FOR THE PURPOSE UNDER CONSIDERATION, THAT THE THEOLOGICAL VIRTUES OF FAITH, HOPE, LOVE OF GOD AND NEIGHBOUR, AND THE CARDINAL VIRTUES, PRUDENCE, JUSTICE, TEMPERANCE, FORTITUDE, AND SUBORDINATE VIRTUES OF THE VENERABLE SERVANT OF GOD, CATHERINE TEKAKWITHA, WERE HEROIC.























Favours from Venerable Tekakwitha
