
May we enjoy well your creative beauty that surrounds us and reverence it with respect and care.

You send us the soft winds and rains from the direction we are now facing.


Soften our troubles and cool them with your refreshing breeze.

Prayer Facing East


O Great Father, Maker of all that is, who always has been,

You are the beginning and the end. We do not always understand your ways but we trust you because you are our God and we are your people.


Hear us today, our groanings are sad and mournful, our voices shaky, our vision blurred and our hearts heavy with grief because one of our young ones has gone from us.
