

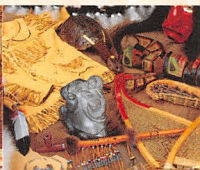

## Le Huron Boutique

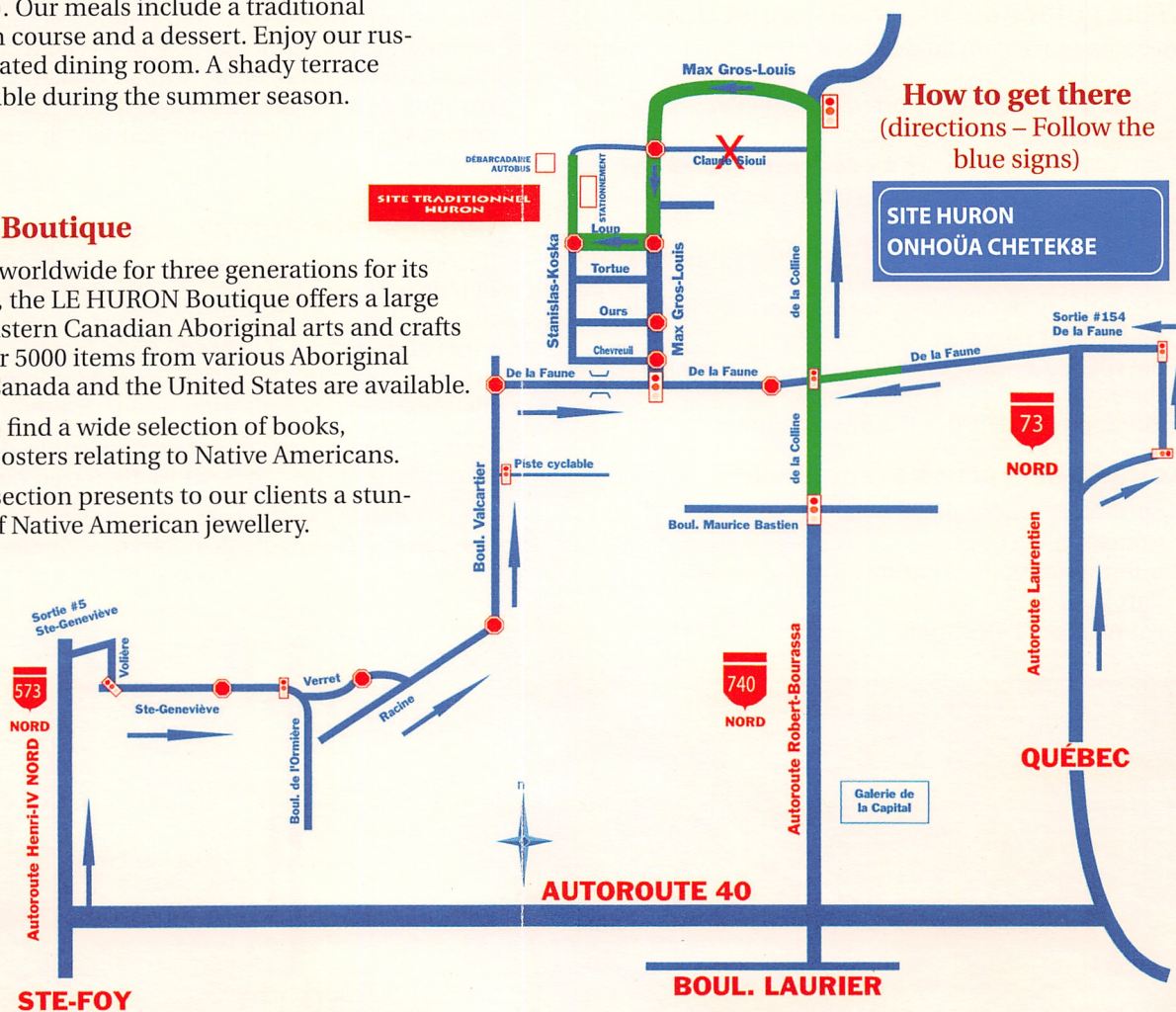

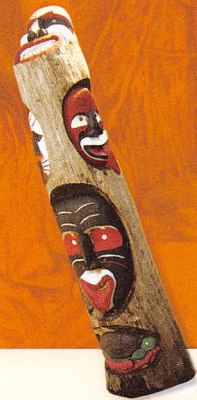
