- 1826 - Born at Mohawk Indian in Aukwilla,  
N. Y.  
1875 - Baptized a Christian at Fonda, N. Y.  
1877 - Journeyed through Amsterdam, N. Y.  
along the Chocomaude L. and  
arrived in Canada.  
1880 - Died at Congrewoya, Canada.  
1883 - Proclaimed Venerable by Pope Pius XI.  
Born of noble Katak preached and practiced love,  
peace and understanding all her life. Her noble  
character, her love for the state of nature and her  
enlightened attitude toward the environment make  
her an inspiring patroness of Ecology.
