

GREETINGS FROM THE DIRECTOR



Dear Readers, Greetings faithful readers,

I wish you and your families are enjoying a restful and enjoyable summer season. If you have upcoming vacation time to take, good for you. Everyone needs

time to recharge their batteries. And if your vacation time has ended, I hope that you and your families enjoyed yourself and created some happy memories in your travels.

This worker has been kept busy with church-related issues in the last several months. The future of the Kateri Center, its budget and operations and relationship to the Mission has been the subject of on-going discussions.

The cost of producing issues is increasing, subscriptions are down, rent is a constant expense. The one positive is that the Kateri Center holds a lot of inventory of medals, books, media, 3rd-class relics, prayer cards and Kateri memorabilia, which could be applied to the transfer of the Guild to the Shrine along with the rental fee of our premises (300 sq feet) that we pay to the Shrine if the Mission finds this acceptable. More details are found on page 12.

A positive development has taken place where the Mission has been granted money by the Quebec department for Heritage to make necessary upgrades to the Church, windows and stone work. The total estimate for repairs is around \$250,000. There will be a need to fundraise a portion of money which is broken down by percentage. We are to raise 30% of funds, and Quebec to chip in 70 % to cover the balance. This worker as part of the Finance and Administration committee can provide further updates in the future.

Another part of the Mission that is getting a facelift is our Gift Shop that is continually receiving visitors from all over the world. Some of these visitors arrive by tour bus from Montreal. This is another way to spread the name of St. Kateri.

This worker will have updates about the Knights of Columbus Supreme Convention held in Quebec City. This is of interest as Indigenous leaders across Canada and the United States were invited to the event to be honored for their work. I could not attend due to work commitments.

In September, I will attend the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops Assembly in Quebec City. The invitation is to come observe and listen to the discussion and updates in the area of healing and reconciliation and interactions with Indigenous communities.

In summary, there is necessary work to cut costs, improve and enhance the office space and solidify the Church building and rectory of St. Francis Xavier Mission.

Let us all continue to pray to St. Kateri for Her intercession on these matters mentioned here and all our worries and concerns as She brings these to Jesus for His gentle touch. After all, these practical matters are for the community of faith in Kahnawake, and all who have peace and love in their heart and want to share this love with others. What a beautiful mission we have.

May St. Kateri continue to be our role model.

May God bless you and your loved ones.

Faith is always expressed through service. Faith is not about putting on make-up, putting make-up on the soul; no, it is to serve.

Dear brothers and sisters, Kateri's life is further proof that apostolic zeal implies both union with Jesus, nourished by prayer and the sacraments, and the desire to spread the beauty of the Christian message through fidelity to one's particular vocation. Kateri's last words are very beautiful. Before she died, she said, "Jesus, I love you." lesos, konoron:kwa. From its beginnings in 1948, the KATERI magazine had only three editors who were also the Canadian Vice-Postulators for the Cause of Canonization of Kateri Tekakwitha. Most of the articles are from the late Fr Henri Béchard, S.J. who was the longest serving Canadian Vice-Postulator for the Cause of Kateri and Editor of the 'Kateri' magazine (42 years!)

Since 2015, the magazine and the Kateri Center are now under the direction of Thomas Dearhouse (Native Ojibway). They all served at the Saint Francis-Xavier Mission in Kahnawake. They did not necessarily write each and every article, but they have selected articles from various sources and events (native and non-native) based on their religious experience and knowledge and on the mandate of the magazine which was to promote the CAUSE OF KATERI: Her canonization!

#### PARIS OLYMPIC GAMES BLASPHEMY

The Vatican said it was saddened by certain scenes at the opening ceremony that gave offence to Christians, after controversy over a segment that mocked Jesus' Last Supper which included a scene featuring dancers and drag queens that was reminiscent of depictions of Leonardo Da Vinci's Last Supper, the final meal Jesus Christ shared with His apostles. The Holy See can only join the voices that have been raised in recent days to deplore the offence given to the world's worldwide Christians (2.38 billion) and believers of other religions. In a prestigious event where the whole world comes together around common values there should not be allusions ridiculing the religious beliefs of many people, and that allusions ridiculing the religious beliefs of many people, and that "freedom of expression... finds its limit in respect for others."

If this is not blasphemy, which is the ultimate offense to God Himself, what is? The depiction has also found criticism from Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew (Orthodox), former US president Donald Trump, Bishop Robert Barron (USA) who also criticized the ceremony, calling it "a disgusting, arrogant mockery", some US Republican lawmakers, Italy, Hungary, Malta, UK's media icon Piers Morgan saying 'could this have been made against Islam?', Iran's supreme leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei and a group of French bishops, who cited a "mockery of Christianity". Egypt's Al-Azhar, the highest seat of Sunni Muslim learning also condemned this obscenity. Turkey's Erdogan's conversation with Pope Francis underscored the gravity of this event's affront to sacred values. The Middle East Council of Churches also condemned this mockery of Jesus Christ. Not surprisingly, Canada's PM stayed mute! (this is only a partial list).

UNITY IN PERSONAL IDEAL among Native Americans will perhaps become more prevalent through the example of Kateri Tekakwitha· Not only is her lineage a combination of two great North American stocks, the Iroquois and the Algonquian, but her example of courage and unselfishness serves as model for all North American Indians, and, in fact, for Christians of good will everywhere·

UNITY IN SIGN was a mandate from Jesus Christ to his Apostles, when He instructed them at the conclusion of Matthew's Gospel: "Go, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (Matt; 28:19). Thus, the Sign of the Cross has been a source of unity for thousands who had tried to Christianize the nations of the world, including the Indian peoples of North America. It is hoped that the Mohawk Valley, which has been the scene of heroic labors by Christian missionaries and Indians, will be the site of an impressive outdoor cross. Perhaps the combined efforts and talents of Indians and Whites alike will someday produce a majestic reminder not only of the great acts of Christian love and accomplishment of the past, but also tell how these have enriched the Christian life of North America into the present, and, hopefully, for many decades into the future as well.

# PRAY FOR A CEASEFIRE IN GAZA

"Many innocent people have died—among them also children, and this is terrible and unacceptable. Their death is a sign that there is not the will to build the future but the [will] to destroy it," the pope said.

"Every day, in my heart, I carry the pain and suffering of the populations in Palestine and Israel due to the ongoing hostilities," said Pope Francis on Sunday in yet another heartfelt appeal for a ceasefire in Gaza. And expressing grief for "the thousands of dead, the wounded, the displaced, the immense destruction that wreaks pain and suffering on the small and defenceless who see their future compromised." Pope Francis called on all men and women of goodwill to raise their cry for peace. Speaking during the Angelus in St. Peter's Square he asked: "Do we really think we are building a better world in this way?" "Enough, please. Let us all say: Enough, please!" he repeated: "Stop the war." The Pope continued with an appeal to continue negotiations for an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and throughout the region, "so that the hostages may be freed and return to their anxiously awaiting loved ones, and so that the civilian population may have safe access to necessary and urgent humanitarian aid."

Meanwhile, mediators in the Gaza conflict are meeting to try to reach an agreement on a temporary ceasefire between Israel and Hamas. Israel has been waging a war on Gaza after Hamas sprang a deadly surprise attack on Israel in October. Since then, the war has killed 30,320 Palestinians and injured 71,533 in Gaza, most of them children and women.

# Homily by Bishop Claude Hamelin – April 21st, 2024

The first reading that we just heard is from the book of Wisdom which is taken from the collection of celebrations marking the Feast of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha.


Sometimes we say about someone: 'that person is wise'; but what exactly do we mean by that?

We are talking about a person who is:

- -Having a great deal of experience;
- -Providing good advice;
- -Possessing an excellent discernment;
- -Filled with humanity;
- -Exercising prudence;
- -Brimming with a heart full of love

For the sacred writers in the Bible, wisdom

does not exclude the human approach, but goes beyond it.



It is indeed the Holy Spirit who reveals to us the profound meaning of our existence.

The Holy Spirit is the One who centers our lives on love, the love we receive from God and the love we give one another, then our 'paths become straight' and we discover what pleases the Lord.

For Jesus, the truly wise person is someone who commits his whole life to acquiring the Kingdom of Heaven thus does his utmost to "walk in Jesus' footsteps".

Jesus teaches us that the wisdom He wants for us refers to a scale of values/preferences, and among those preferences, Jesus would be the first and foremost preference.

If we want to be wise Christ's way, then we should develop an art of living that reflects our Christianity.

We are invited to follow Him every day through the various circumstances of our lives. That is the choice St Kateri made... She gave her life out of love for the Lord... She was a 'wise person' in the eyes of the Lord.

In today's Gospel which happens to be 'the World Day of Prayer for Vocations', Jesus is presenting Himself to us as one of the oldest trades, of the oldest jobs: That of a Shepherd / Pastor!

The task of a shepherd is a most demanding one as it means walking long distances through fields and to be familiar with its paths and pastures while also looking out for the weakest sheep and keeping watch at night while caring and protecting his flock.



In today's Gospel, Jesus told us that He is the true Shepherd, that He is the good Pastor.

Jesus challenges us and invites us to become true shepherds for one another:

- ...like parents with their children
- ...like teachers with their pupils
- ...like pastors for their Christian communities
- ...like elected officials for their constituents

Yes, we are all called to be shepherds caring for one another.

We are also called to love the people entrusted to our care with the same free, selfless, and passionate love that Jesus had for His own.

St Kateri clearly understood this call from the Lord...

She was a good shepherd for her people, caring for everyone in Her path by embracing them with tenderness, love and mercy.

She also devoted Her whole life to the service of the Lord and is a model for us all to follow through Her simplicity, Her unconditional welcome, Her love of nature, Her life of prayer and unshakable faith.

While She died on Holy Wednesday 1680 at age 24 (344 years ago!), She should and could be considered a source of inspiration for us all.

Since She answered the Lord's call, let us then walk with Her and become closer to the Lord.





